

**YATES CENTER CITY COUNCIL MINUTES  
JULY 7, 2014**

The Yates Center City Council met in regular session on Monday, July 7, 2014, at 7:04pm at City Hall. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.


Council reconvened at 7:55pm.

**CLAIMS AND VOUCHERS**


Motion was made by Stuber, seconded by Reser, to pay the claims and vouchers in the amount of \$60,263.94. Motion carried unanimously.

**ADJOURNMENT**

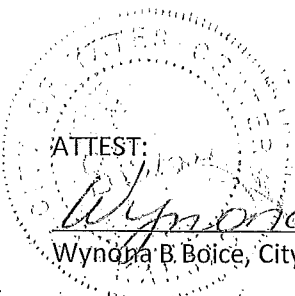
Motion was made by Bishop, seconded by Beecher, to adjourn. Motion carried unanimously and council adjourned at 7:56pm.
