

**YATES CENTER CITY COUNCIL MINUTES
JUNE 16, 2014 – SPECIAL MEETING**

The Yates Center City Council met in special session on Monday, June 16, 2014, at 6:10pm at City Hall.

Items on the agenda included:

1. Discussion and possible decision on cleaning storm drains.
2. Discussion and possible decision on which days to allow alcoholic liquor to be sold.
3. Discussion on a new library.

Mayor Weber called the meeting to order. Roll call as follows: Reser, Jones, Bishop, Black, and Beecher. Absent: Randall, Stuber, and Day. Other city officials present were: Street Superintendent Randy Hegwald, Water Superintendent Eric Boone, and City Clerk Becky Boice.

Mayor Weber informed council that the building being considered for the library had been sold, the discussion was deleted from the agenda.

Motion was made by Beecher, seconded by Bishop, to allow cleaning of the storm drains not to exceed \$2,000.00, when Utility Maintenance was in town to clean sewer lines. Motion carried unanimously.




Motion was made by Black, seconded by Bishop, to change the holiday dates when alcoholic liquor can be sold to match which dates the state allows. This would allow alcoholic liquor to be sold on Memorial Day, the 4th of July, and Labor Day. Motion carried unanimously. An ordinance to be presented for adoption at the next meeting.

Motion was made by Bishop, seconded by Beecher, to adjourn. Motion carried unanimously and council adjourned to a work session at 6:20pm.
