

**YATES CENTER CITY COUNCIL MINUTES
JUNE 24, 2013**

BID POLICY WAIVED**

BATTERY CHARGER WATER PLANT

Motion was made by Beecher, seconded by Bishop, to purchase a continuous charge battery charger for the stationary generator at the water plant from Cummins Central Power of Wichita for \$780.00 plus shipping. Motion carried unanimously.

SEWER TRUCK DISCUSSION

Discussion was held on buying a sewer vacuum truck. It was the consensus of the council to have Boone decide on a specific truck and bring the detailed information to next council meeting.

PARKS

Day requested discussion on the lake ordinances be tabled for two weeks.

MAYOR COMMENTS


Reser congratulated Mayor Weber on the recent birth of his twin sons.
