

**YATES CENTER CITY COUNCIL MINUTES  
JUNE 6, 2017**

The Yates Center City Council met in regular session on Tuesday, June 6, 2017, at City Hall. The meeting was moved from Monday, June 5, due to lack of a quorum. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Council member Reser called the meeting to order at 7:05pm. Roll call as follows: Reser, Beecher, Spoon, Bishop, Stuber, and Jones. Absent: Weber, Randall, and Day. Other city officials present included: City Attorney Brian Duncan, Water Superintendent Eric Boone, Street Superintendent Randy Hegwald, Deputy Chief of Police Ken Leedy, and City Clerk Becky Boice.

**AGENDA APPROVED**

Motion was made by Bishop, seconded by Stuber, to approve the agenda as printed. Motion carried unanimously.

**MINUTES APPROVED**

Motion was made by Bishop, seconded by Stuber, to approve the minutes of the May 15, 2017, meeting as printed. Motion carried unanimously.

**CITY ATTORNEY**

Duncan had nothing at this time.

**WEBER ARRIVED**

Mayor Weber arrived at 7:10pm and Reser returned to his council seat.

**COMMITTEE REPORTS  
ADMINISTRATIVE  
BIKES**

Reser informed council that the city has a collection of bikes that have been found and not claimed over the past several years. Discussion was held on putting the bikes up for sealed bids. It was the consensus of the council to try and find kids in the community in need of a bike and donate them instead.

**SHAWN BONHAM**

Shawn Bonham was present to request to be allowed to keep a storage container on his property. He had received notice from the city that he needed to remove it. Duncan advised Mr. Bonham that this was against city ordinance but he could put his request in writing to the city council if he wanted it discussed.

Motion was made by Reser, seconded by Spoon, to enter into a 10 minute executive session for attorney/client privilege to discuss matters which are confidential. Motion carried unanimously. Council entered executive session at 8:08pm to reconvene at 8:18pm.

Council reconvened at 8:18pm.

**EXECUTIVE SESSION**

Motion was made by Reser, seconded by Beecher, to enter into a 15 minute executive session for attorney/client privilege to discuss matters which are confidential. Motion carried unanimously. Council entered executive session at 8:20pm to reconvene at 8:35pm.

Boone presented a quote from Murphy Tractor for repair of the backhoe. Motion was made by Reser, seconded by Beecher, to have Murphy Tractor repair the backhoe not exceeding \$5000.00. Motion carried unanimously.

After discussion was held on a purchasing a truck with a utility bed for the water department the decision was tabled for two weeks until Randall could be at the meeting.

**BOAT REPAIRS**

Hegwald informed council that the motor on the city boat used to fill the fish feeders quit running. The boat and motor are over 20 years old and last year when the motor was repaired he was told it was worn out. He did have prices on new motors and/or boat packages. After discussion several council members were going to do some checking on getting the motor fixed. Justin Morrison with KDWPT is filling the feeders until the motor is repaired or replaced.

**MILLFOIL**

Hegwald informed council that the millfoil at the Yates Center Reservoir needed to be treated again and that it is now in the kids pond. KDWPT is willing to help with chemical to treat the kids pond. Hegwald to get a map from Justin Morrison on what areas of the reservoir need to be treated.

**CDBG CLOSEOUT HEARING**

Motion was made by Jones, seconded by Bishop, to set the Community Development Block Grant closeout hearing for Monday, June 19, 2017, at 7:00pm. Motion carried with Spoon abstaining. The hearing will close out the grant for the ADA improvements at the park, South Owl Lake, and the ballfields.

**MAYOR COMMENTS**


Weber thanked council for being able to meet tonight with the lack of quorum on Monday night.

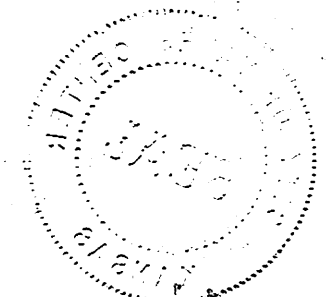
