**OPEN BURNING**

**POOL VACUUM** 

Jones presented a bid from Jim Graham for a Hayward 1HP Super Pump, 35' vacuum hose, a vacuum head, and a vacuum cart. Motion was made by Bishop, seconded by Beecher, to purchase the vacuum and accessories for the pool from Jim Graham not to exceed \$850. Motion carried with Day and Jones abstaining.

**BALL FIELDS UPDATE** 

Jones reported that the street department had finished tearing down the old concession stand at the ball fields. He also listed all the improvements that have been made or are in progress.
