

**YATES CENTER CITY COUNCIL MINUTES
OCTOBER 14, 2013**

City Council met in regular session on Monday, October 14, 2013, at 7:05pm at City Hall. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Mayor Weber called the meeting to order. Roll call as follows: Reser, Randall, Day, Beecher, Stuber, and Bishop. Absent: Black and Jones. Other city officials present included: City Attorney Tom Mikulka, Street Superintendent Randy Hegwald, Chief of Police Lyle Kee, Deputy Chief of Police Ken Leedy, and City Clerk Becky Boice.

AGENDA AMENDED & APPROVED

Stuber amended the agenda to add under the safety committee report opening bids for a new police car. Motion was made by Stuber, seconded by Bishop, to approve the agenda as amended. Motion carried unanimously.

MINUTES APPROVED

Motion was made by Day, seconded by Stuber, to approve the minutes of the September 30, 2013, council meeting as printed. Motion carried unanimously.

CITY ATTORNEY

Mikulka had nothing to report.

DON NEWMAN

**COMMITTEE REPORTS
ADMINISTRATIVE
BUSINESS INCENTIVES**

Council discussed the proposed business incentives. Motion was made by Day, seconded by Stuber, to adopt the proposed incentives with the changes discussed. Motion carried unanimously.

COREY GREEN GRANT APPLICATION

Day present a Yates Center Historic Square Economic Development Grant application from Corey Green for the building located at 118 West Rutledge. Motion was made by Day, seconded by Bishop, to award the grant in the amount of \$3,500.00, with funds to come out of Downtown Development. Motion carried unanimously.

BLUE CROSS & BLUE SHIELD RATES

Day informed Council that the rates for the city's Blue Cross and Blue Shield insurance plan had decreased by 12.6%, saving the city \$5,917.20 for the upcoming year.

MAYOR COMMENTS


Weber had nothing to report.

CLAIMS & VOUCHERS

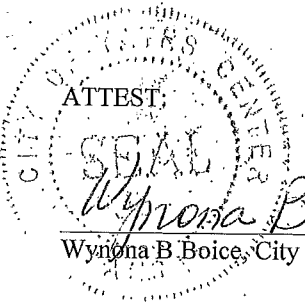
Motion was made by Day, seconded by Beecher, to pay the claims and vouchers in the amount of \$53,143.57. Motion carried unanimously.
