

**YATES CENTER CITY COUNCIL MEETING

The Yates Center City Council met in regular session on Monday, July 3, 2017, at City Hall. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

**MAYOR COMMENTS**


Weber had nothing to comment on.

**CLAIMS & VOUCHERS**

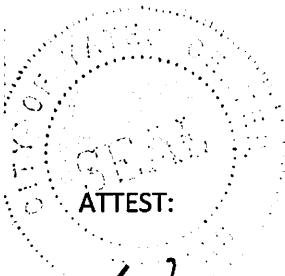
Motion was made by Reser, seconded by Day, to pay the claims and vouchers in the amount of \$116,156.16. Motion carried unanimously.
