**YATES CENTER SPECIAL COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES
NOVEMBER 29, 2017**

The Yates Center City Council met in special session on Wednesday, November 29, 2017, at City Hall.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Mayor Weber called the meeting to order at 6:00pm. Council present: Randall, Reser, Stuber, Bishop, Wiehn, Spoon, Jones, and Beecher. Other city officials present: City Attorney Brian Duncan, Police Chief Lyle Kee, and City Clerk Becky Boice.

The purpose of the meeting was to discuss police department positions and personnel.

EXECUTIVE SESSIONS

Motion was made by Bishop, seconded by Beecher, to enter into a 15 minute executive session for non-elected personnel because if this matter were discussed in open session it might invade the privacy of those discussed. Motion carried unanimously. Council entered into executive session at 6:03pm to reconvene at 6:18pm.

Council reconvened at 6:18pm.

Motion was made by Bishop, seconded by Beecher, to continue the executive session for the same reason for an additional 20 minutes. Motion carried unanimously. Council re-entered into executive session at 6:19pm to reconvene at 6:39pm.

Council reconvened at 6:39pm.

CHIEF APPLICATIONS


