

**YATES CENTER CITY COUNCIL MINUTES
NOVEMBER 5, 2018**

Yates Center City Council met in regular session on Monday, November 5, 2018, at City Hall. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

President of the Council Wiehn called the meeting to order at 7:00pm. Roll call as follows: Reser, Randall, Beecher, Spoon, Cathcard, Shaffer, and Jones. Absent: Weber. Other city officials present included: City Attorney Brian Duncan, Public Works Supervisor Eric Boone, Chief of Police Doug Smoot, Police Officer Jenia Hanson, and City Clerk Becky Boice.

AGENDA AMENDED & APPROVED

Spoon removed discussion on the dispatching contract from safety and added a 15 minute executive session under safety.

Cathcard added a 5 minute executive session under administrative.

Motion was made by Reser, seconded by Randall, to approve the agenda as amended. Motion carried unanimously.

MINUTES APPROVED

Motion was made by Reser, seconded by Beecher, to approve the minutes of the October 15, 2018, council meeting as printed. Motion carried unanimously.

FOREST HOWARD CODE HEARING

Forest and Glenda Howard were present to request a 90-day extension to get in compliance with a code violation.

After discussion, it was the consensus of the council to allow Howard 90 days from October 19, 2018, to get in code compliance.

Duncan had nothing to report at this time.

Motion was made by Reser, seconded by Spoon, to pay the claims and vouchers in the amount of \$237,659.43. Motion carried unanimously.


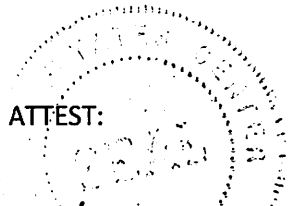
ADJOURNMENT
