

**YATES CENTER CITY COUNCIL MINUTES
SPECIAL MEETING – FEBRUARY 11, 2019**

Yates Center City Council met in special session on Monday, February 11, 2019, at City Hall. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

The meeting was called to approve the contract between the City of Yates Center and UMC regarding swimming pool renovations.

President of the Council Wiehn called the meeting to order at 6:00pm. Present: Reser, Randall, Beecher, Spoon, Cathcard, Shaffer, and Jones. Absent: Mayor Weber. Other city officials present included: City Attorney Brian Duncan, Public Works Supervisor Eric Boone, Chief of Police Doug Smoot, Deputy City Clerk Tia Steele, and City Clerk Becky Boice.

Motion was made by Reser, seconded by Randall, to enter into a 15 minute executive session in the council room for attorney/client privilege for the purpose of discussing with the city attorney matters of a confidential character and which is private, with no third parties present. Motion carried unanimously. Council entered into executive session at 6:05pm to reconvene at 6:20pm.


Council reconvened at 6:20pm. Mayor Weber arrived and called the meeting back to order.


Council reconvened at 6:36pm.

Motion carried unanimously and council adjourned at 6:37pm.


