Yates Center City Council met in regular session on Monday, June 3, 2019, at City Hall. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

President of the Council Wiehn called the meeting to order at 7:05pm. Roll call as follows: Reser, Randall, Beecher, Shaffer, and Wiehn. Absent: Mayor Weber, Spoon, and Cathcard. One position vacant. Other city officials present included: City Attorney Brian Duncan, Public Works Supervisor Eric Boone, Chief of Police Doug Smoot, and City Clerk Becky Boice.

AGENDA AMENDED & APPROVED

Beecher added fire department roof repair under safety.

Beecher removed the executive session under safety.

Motion was made by Reser, seconded by Beecher, to approve the agenda as amended. Motion carried unanimously.

After a brief discussion on the time allowed for residents to pickup their trash that is blowing in other people's yards, it was the consensus of the council to have Duncan check into the matter and have a draft available at the next meeting on his recommendation for a solution.

REQUESTED SIGNS

Beecher presented a request for the following signs:

- Speed limit signs on Skinner north of the high school
- Stop sign at Skinner and Highland
- Stop sign at Skinner and Prairie

Motion was made by Beecher, seconded by Shaffer to install the signs as requested. Motion carried with Randall voting no.

FIRE DEPT ROOF

Beecher informed council that the fire department roof was leaking. Motion was made by Beecher, seconded by Randall, to give Fire Chief Gaulding permission to solicit bids for the roof repair. Gaulding to have specifications available and have a minimum of three bids. Bids due by 5:00pm, on Monday, June 17. Motion carried with Reser abstaining.

PARKS & PUBLIC LANDS

Duncan presented a Memorandum of Understanding for The City of Yates Center and TS Construction to sign for the recently awarded bid for erosion repair on the piers at the Yates Center Reservoir.

CLAIMS & VOUCHERS

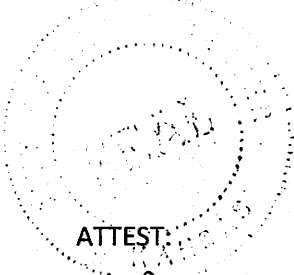
Motion was made by Reser, seconded by Beecher, to pay the claims and vouchers in the amount of \$89,331.47. Motion carried unanimously.
