

**YATES CENTER CITY COUNCIL MINUTES  
JANUARY 4, 2021**

Yates Center City Council met in regular session on Monday, January 4, 2021, at City Hall. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Parks & Public Lands – Wiehn (chair), Reser, Shaffer, Cathcard


Motion was made by Reser, seconded by Stewart, to approve the mayor’s committee and chair appointments. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion was made by Reser, seconded by Reed, to pay the claims and vouchers in the amount of \$161,106.43. Motion carried unanimously.


**ADJOURNMENT**
