

ORDINANCE NO. 1159

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 1, ARTICLE 6, SECTION NO. 1-609 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF YATES CENTER, REQUESTS TO BE DIRECTED TO CUSTODIANS

BE IT ORDAINED by the Governing Body of the City of Yates Center, Kansas:

SECTION 1: Yates Center Municipal Code Chapter 1, Article 6, Section 1-609 is hereby amended to read and provide as follows:

1-609. Requests to be directed to custodians.

(a) All members of the public, in seeking access to, or copies of, a public record in accordance with the provisions of the Kansas Open Records Act, shall address their requests to the custodian charged with responsibility for the maintenance of the record sought to be inspected or copied.


(b) Whenever any city officer or employee appointed or designated as a custodian under this article is presented with a request for access to, or copy of, a public record which record the custodian does not have in his or her possession and for which he or she has not been given responsibility to keep and maintain, the custodian shall so advise the person requesting the record. Further, the person making the request shall be informed as to which custodian the request should be addressed to, if such is known by the custodian receiving the request.


(c) Under K.S.A. 45-221(a)(14), the City of Yates Center will not disclose the correspondence or identity of any citizen or other person regarding tips or information involving criminal investigations, code enforcement investigations, zoning investigations, work permit investigations, or similar types of actions or investigations taken by the City.

SECTION 2: This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its adoption and publication on the City website, as provided by law.
