

ORDINANCE NUMBER 1168

AN ORDINANCE PERMANANETLY PLACING “NO PARKING” SIGNS ON THE WEST SIDE OF SOUTH MAIN STREET, YATES CENTER, KANSAS BETWEEN THE STREETS OF MARY AND CHELLIS

BE IT ORDAINED by the Governing Body of the City of Yates Center, Kansas;

Whereas, a request has been made by Chief of Police Michael Strode to permanently place “NO PARKING” signs on the west side of south Main Street between the streets of Mary and Chellis after he had exercised his authority to do so on a temporary basis.

Whereas, the Governing Body of the City of Yates Center, Kansas, has determined it is advisable to do so honoring the Chief’s request.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF YATES CENTER, KANSAS, as follows:

Section 1: There shall be “NO PARKING” signs on the west side of south Main Street between the streets of Mary and Chellis.

Section 2: Any violation of this ordinance shall be treated in the same manner as a violation of parking where prohibited as found in the Standard Uniform Traffic Ordinances for Kansas Cities adopted by the City each year.

Section 2: EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall take effect after its publication in the official newspaper of publication for the City, as provided by law.

Passed by the Governing Body of the City of Yates Center, Kansas, this 17th day of April 2023, and approved by the Mayor on such date.
