

RESOLUTION NO. 359

A RESOLUTION creating a temporary common consumption area in three locations in the City of Yates Center, Kansas on May 27, 2023 and May 28, 2023, for the celebration of Yates Center Days.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF YATES CENTER:

WHEREAS the City of Yates Center, Kansas has in the past passed resolutions allowing alcoholic liquor and cereal malt beverage possession and consumption in “beer garden” areas around the town square for the celebration of Yates Center Days.

WHEREAS the City wishes to use its authority as granted by the State to create a temporary common consumption in two areas to serve a greater amount of people than before to celebrate Yates Center Days in 2023.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF YATES CENTER, KANSAS:


Section 1: For the first common consumption area, Main Street, South Street, and Rutledge Street be temporarily barricaded with signage not allowing motorized traffic on these streets extending south from the south edge of Butler Street at the intersections of Butler Street and Main Street and Butler Street and State Street to the north edge of the alleyway on those same streets just south of Rutledge Street and extending from east to west from the east edge of the alleyway just west of State Street to the west edge of the alleyway just east of Main Street for the first common consumption area.

Section 2. Possession and consumption of alcoholic liquor and cereal malt beverage consumption shall be allowed temporarily within this described boundary or area only between the hours of 8:00 a.m. on May 27, 2023 and 1:00 a.m. of May 28, 2023.

Section 3. Aside from this temporary allowance, all other local and State laws must be observed.
