

ORDINANCE NO. 1171

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 14-501 (a) OF THE CITY OF YATES CENTER, KANSAS CODE REGARDING THE OPERATION OF GOLF CARTS BETWEEN THE HOURS OF SUNSET TO SUNRISE WITHIN THE CITY'S LIMITS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF YATES CENTER, KANSAS:

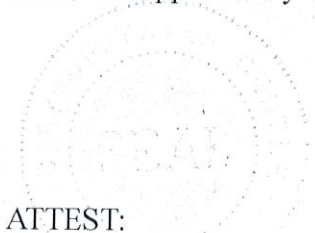
SECTION 1. Section 14 – 501 (a) of the Yates Center City Code be amended to allow, as provided by Kansas statutes, Golf Carts to operate between the hours of sunset to sunrise if the vehicle complies with all lighting requirements for motorcycles as defined in K.S.A. 8-180 *et. seq.*

SECTION 2. The new subsection (a) a 14 – 501 shall state:


- (a) A Golf Cart may be operated upon the public highways, streets, roads, and alleys (streets and roads) within the corporate limits of the City between the hours of sunrise to sunset subject to the provisions of this article, except that, a Golf Cart that is in compliance with the lighting requirements for motorcycles as defined in K.S.A. 18-180 *et. seq.* and having a properly mounted slow-moving vehicle emblem as required by K.S.A. 8-1717 may be operated at any time of day or night under K.S.A. 8-15,108 (c). Specifically, Golf Carts must have headlamps that comply with K.S.A. 18-1801; tail lamps that comply with that comply with K.S.A. 18-1802; reflectors that comply with K.S.A. 18-1803; stop lamps and turn signals that comply with K.S.A. 18-1804; and multiple-beam road-lighting equipment that comply with K.S.A. 18-1805.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect following its adoption and publication in the official City newspaper of the Yates Center News.

Passed by the Governing Body of the City of Yates Center, Kansas, this 3rd day of July 2023, and approved by the Mayor on such date.


